

Instructions for Writing Your

"Confirmation Request" Letter to Our Pastor

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, you shall reaffirm your Baptism and be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit. As a sign of your commitment to your faith development, you are requested to <u>write a letter</u> to our Pastor, **Father Sean Magaldi**, describing your desire to be confirmed.

In your letter, please include the following elements:

- State your chosen **Confirmation Name**
- Briefly describe the life of the Saint you chose to report on and why their story is significant to you.
- Tell Father who you have chosen to be your sponsor, and describe why is this person special in your life?
- Explain to Father why you want to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- List the Acts of Service projects you have participated in, and describe what you have learned from these experiences.
- Explain what you are doing now to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

This letter should be typed on stationery paper or can be either handwritten in pen (not pencil) on writing stationary, not on lined loose-leaf paper. If typed, choose a font size of between 12 to 14 pts on $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" white paper. Please address your letter to the pastor or our church, **Rev. Sean Magaldi, Pastor**.

This letter will be collected at the 8^{th} Grade Mass scheduled:

OCTOBER 19th, 2024.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> Your letter is to be <u>signed</u> and <u>witnessed</u> by your parents / guardians (with both their names typed <u>under</u> their signature) and then signed by you (with your name typed <u>under</u> your signature).
